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## Shape Board Game

## Game prep:

1. Print this page and the game board page (heavy duty paper, such as cardstock is recommended).
2. Cut out the arrow at the bottom of this page.
3. (Optional) Laminate the pieces for extra sturdiness.
4. Affix the arrow to the center of the spinner circle on the board game page using a paper fastener.
5. Gather coins (such as pennies/dimes), little buttons, or other small items so that each player has a unique piece to use as a game pawn.

## Game play:

1. Place pawns on the start square.
2. Players take turns spinning the shape spinner, and going to the next corresponding shape on the game board path.
3. Players continue around the board until a player reaches the finish square.
