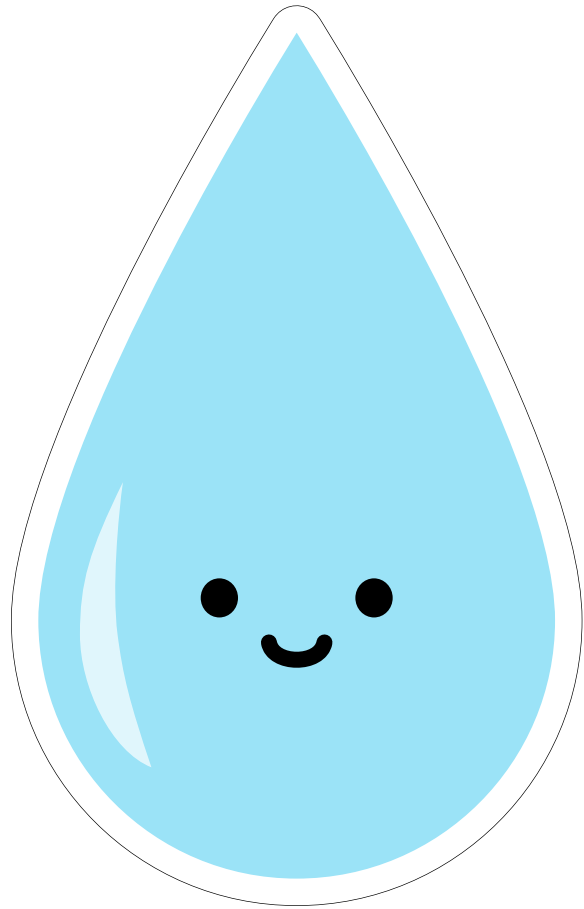
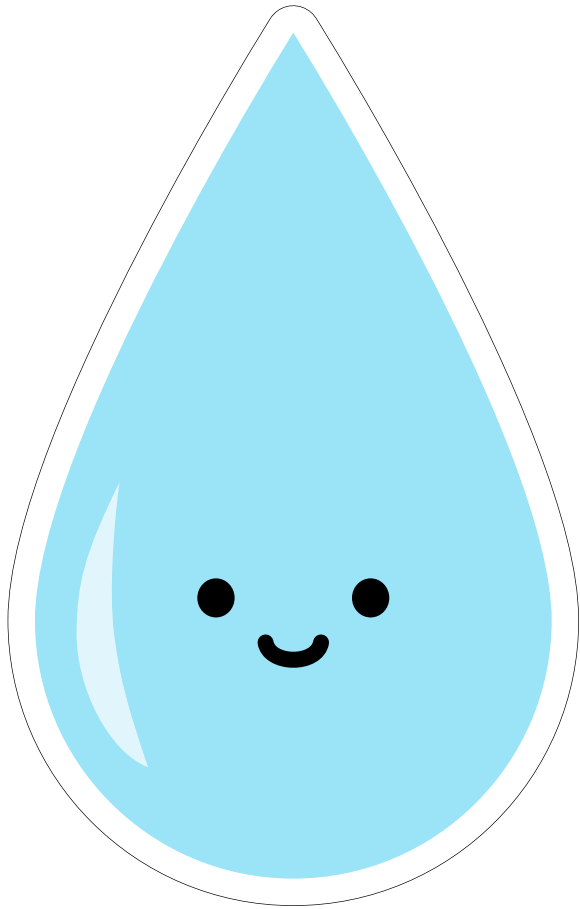
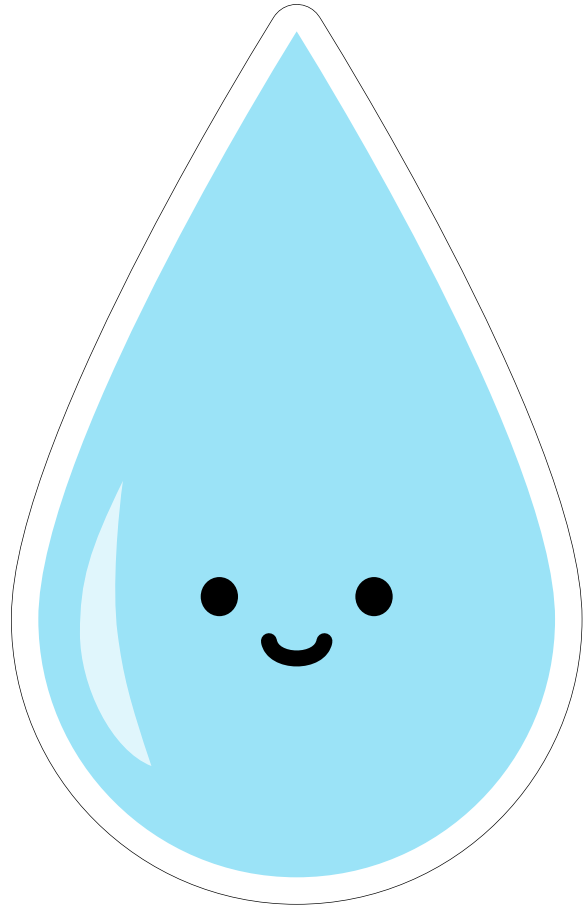
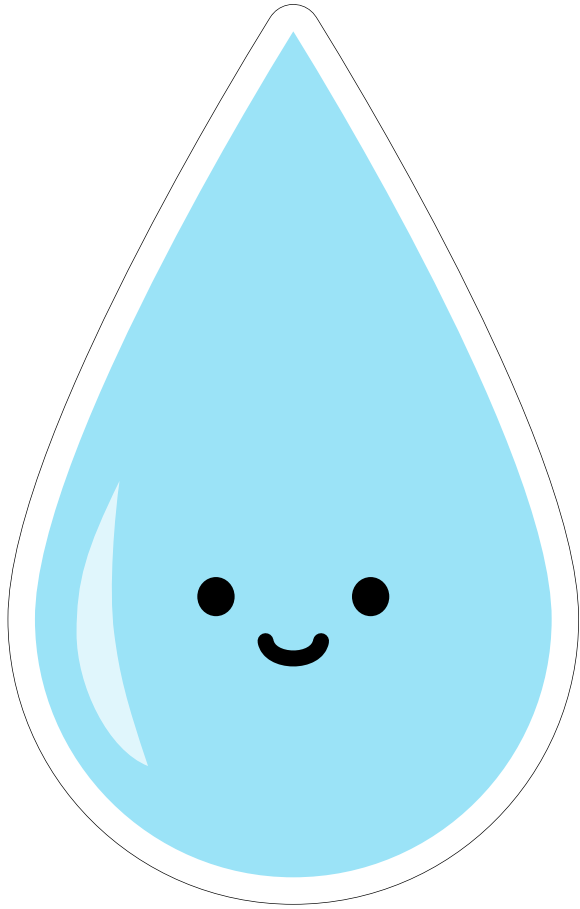


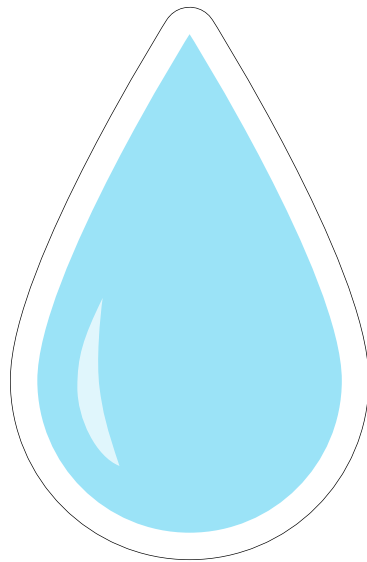
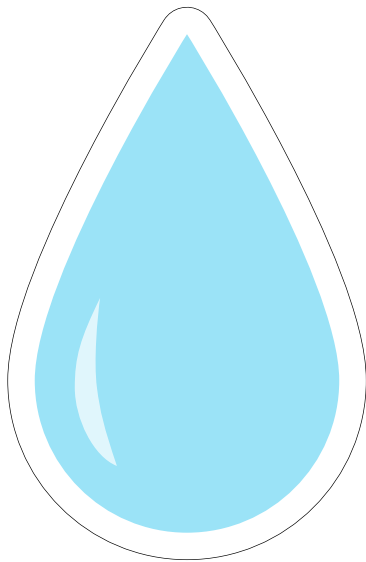
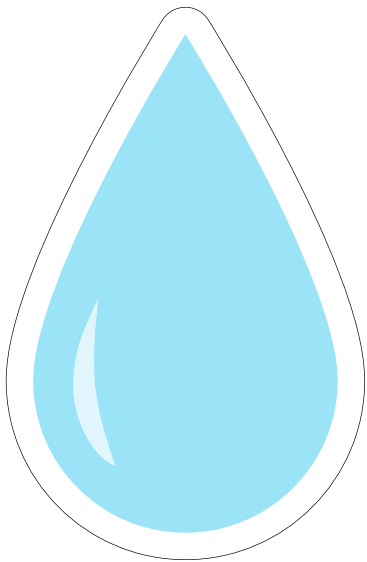
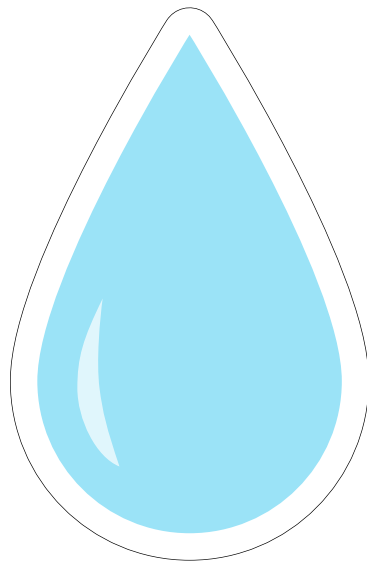
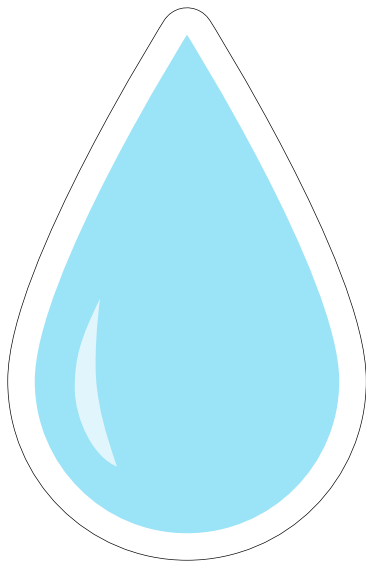
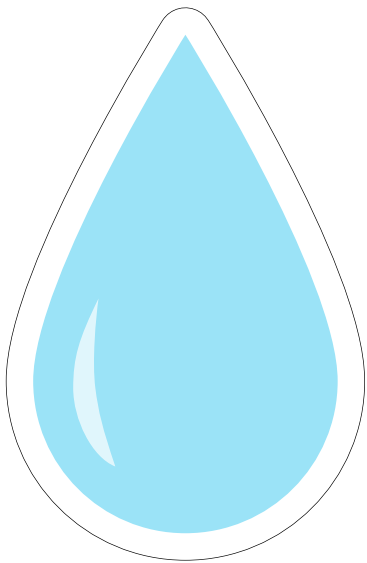
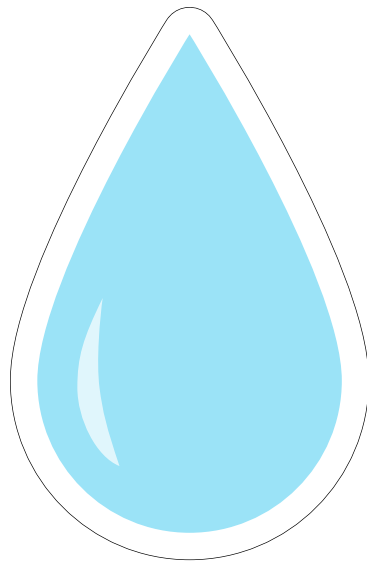
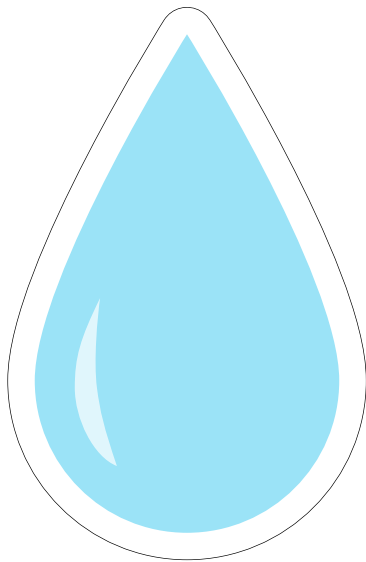
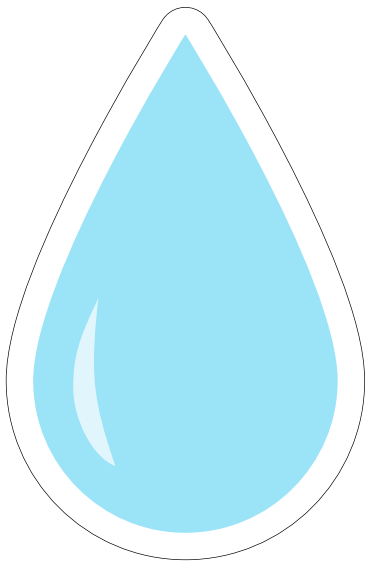


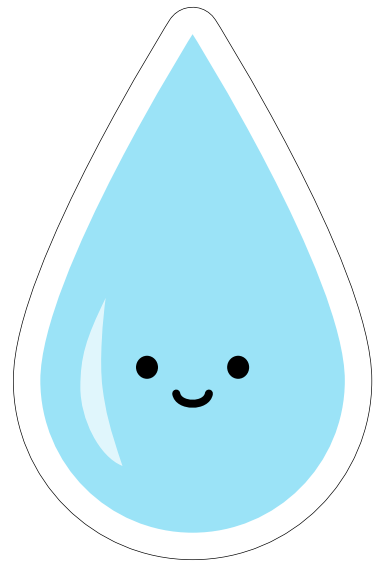
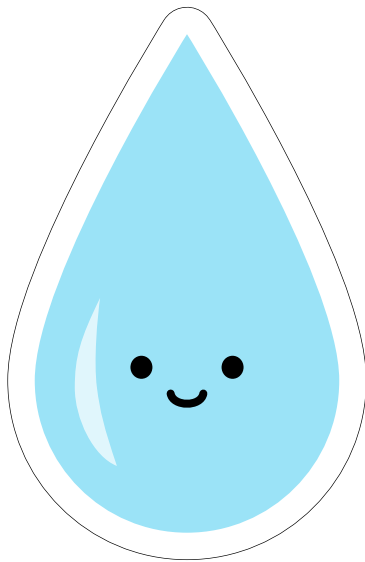
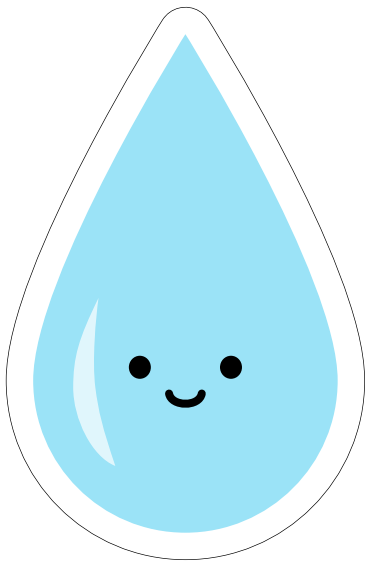
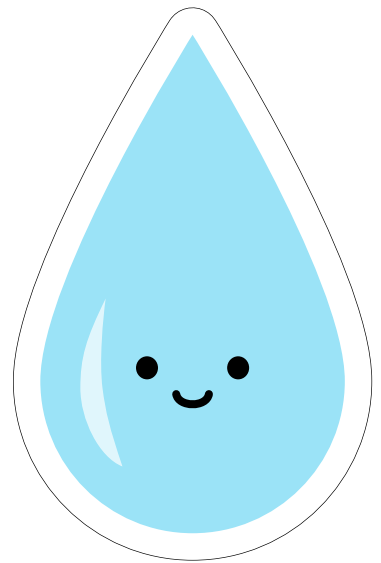
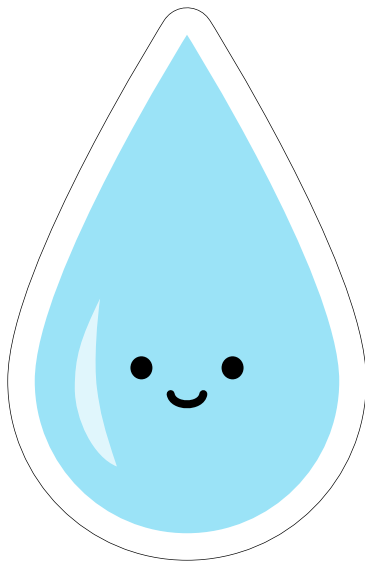
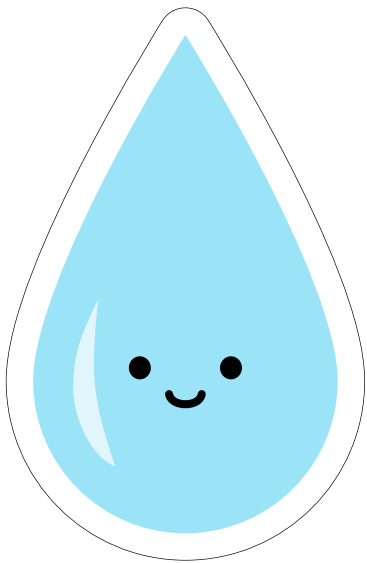
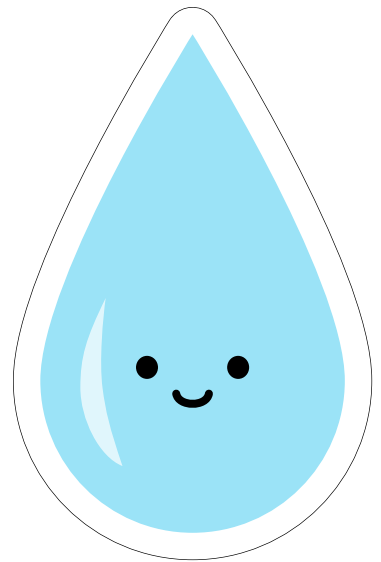
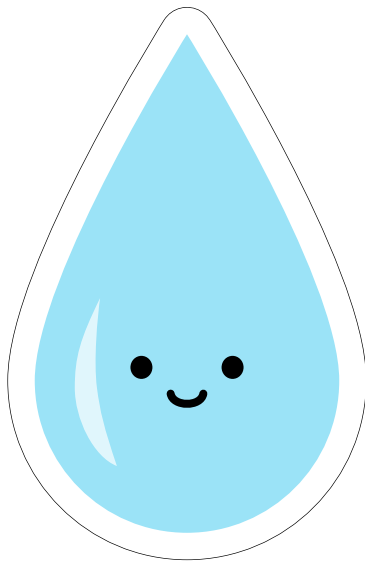
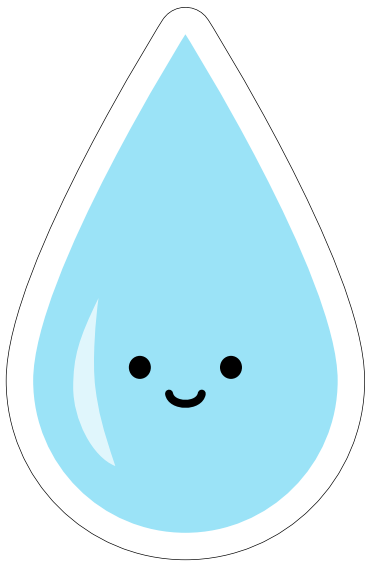


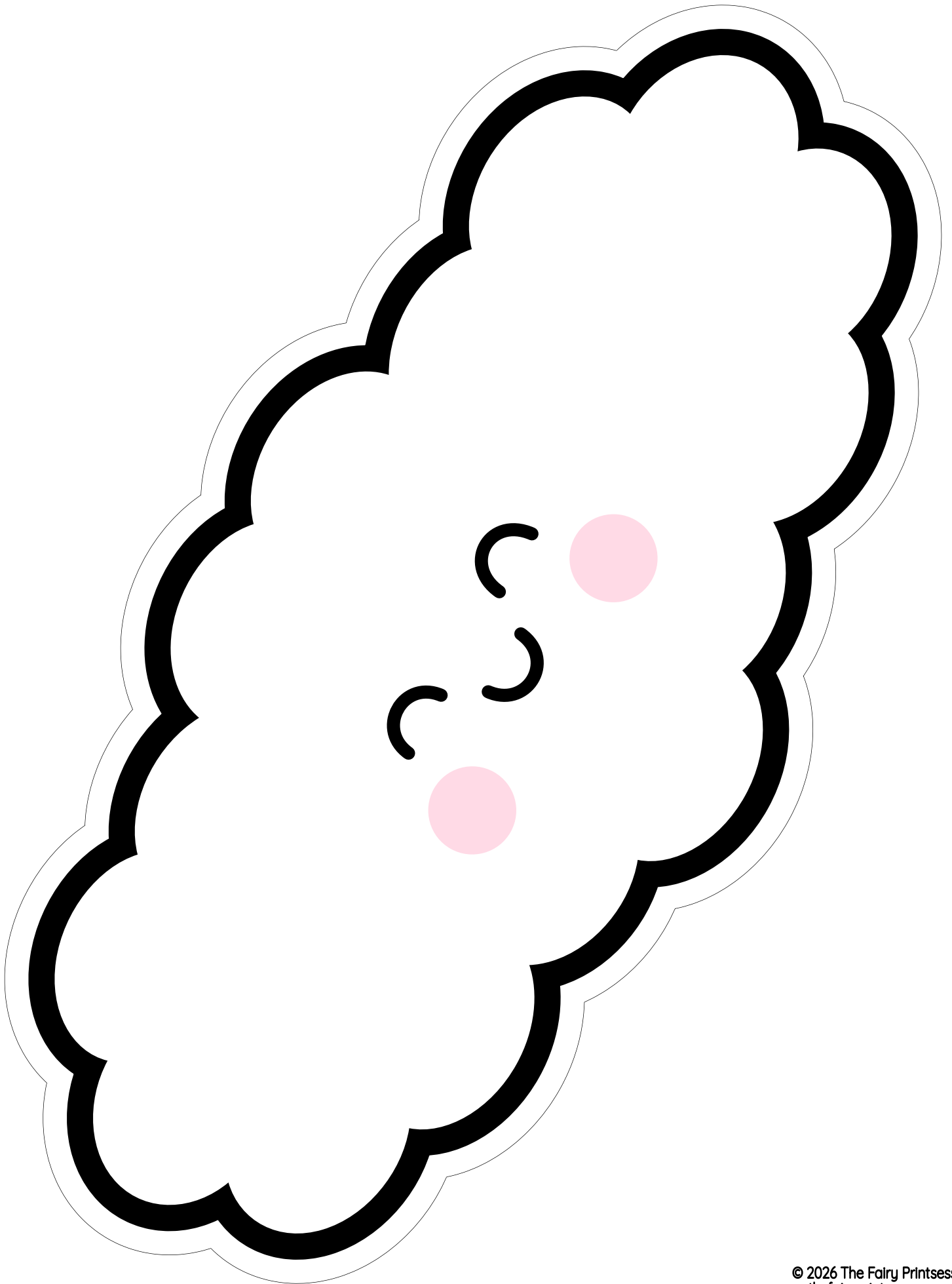


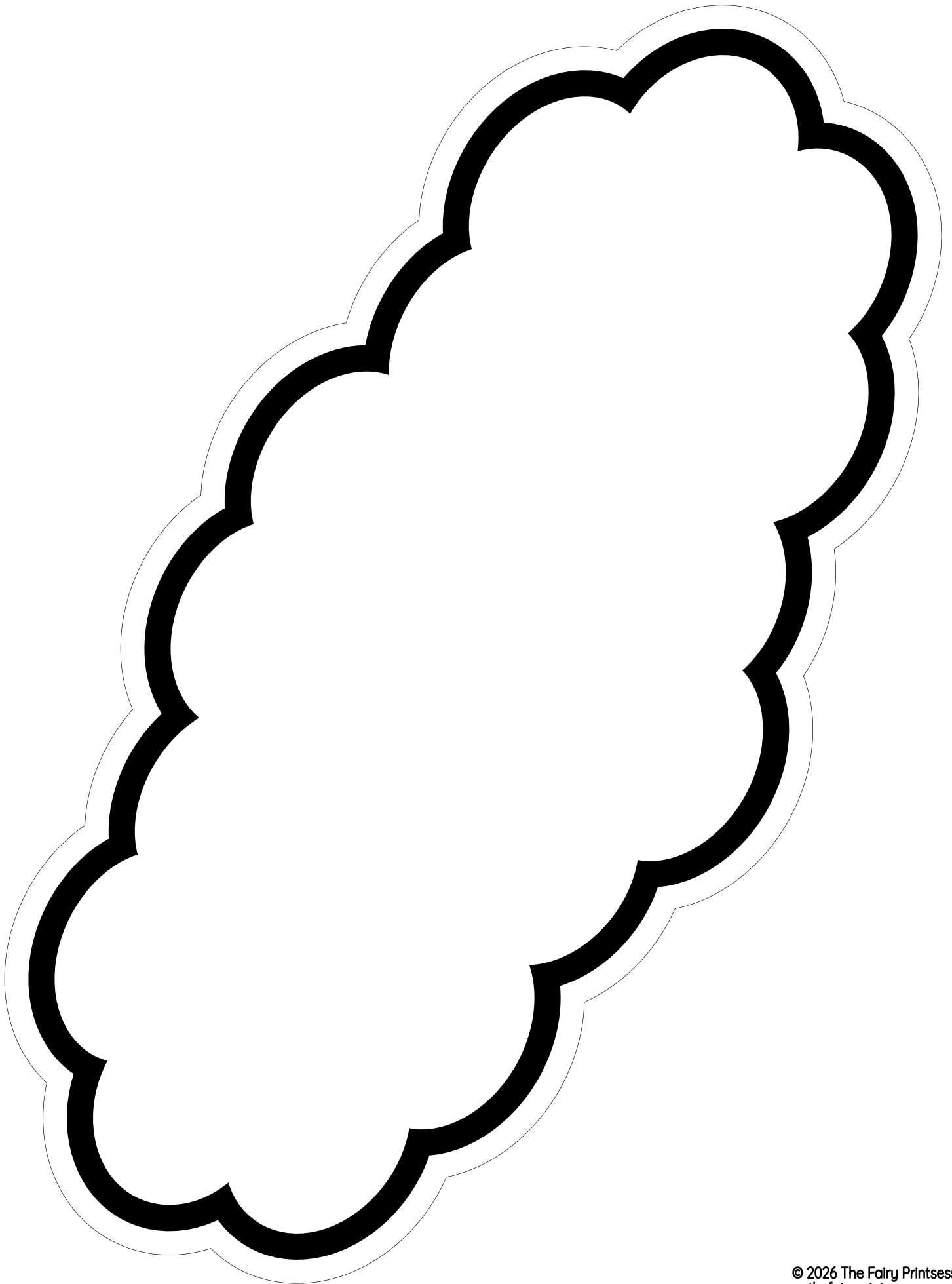












2 methods for adding faces to images:

Start by cutting out the images below (including the face template if you want to use method 1).

1. Use the face template to draw an oval shape around a student's face on a printed photo. Cut out the face along the traced line and glue/tape it onto one of the raincoat images from this page. Repeat for each student.

2. Use a hobby knife to precisely cut out the white face ovals on the raincoat images. Place a student's photo behind each raincoat image aligning each student's face with the area you cut out. Trim any excess photo that sticks out beyond the raincoat image. Then, glue/tape the photo in place on the back of the cutout image.
